Foxes are controversial animals - they are beautiful with a strokeability factor, but shrewd and considered rogues. Foxes are part of the canine family, and they are predators that are largely active at dusk and at night.

Foxes are omnivores and eat anything at all, although they prefer rabbits, chickens and voles, and fruit or berries.

Foxes live in places with sufficient protection - from

polders, dunes and woods to the outskirts of villages and cities. Foxes are smart with a fantastic ability to adapt to their environment. The size of their territories can range from 50 to 900 hectares, depending on the amount of available food and the measures that are applied. For decades, our Gallagher solutions have been used successfully to protect chickens or other small animals with Gallagher electric fencing. Over the past few years there have been successful projects, where meadow birds were protected from foxes by using Gallagher electric fencing

GALLAGHER'S ADVICEFOR KEEPING FOXES OUT

Many people choose traditional fencing with wire mesh or wood and think that will keep foxes out. Unfortunately, this is rarely the case. Foxes are shrewd and when they are hungry they will do whatever it takes to get their tasty morsel. In those situations, climbing and digging are completely obvious solutions to a fox. If you really want efficient fencing that keeps foxes out, there is only one solution - electric fencing. After the first contact with this fencing, foxes will stay away from it. A fox will not receive a shock from the same fencing twice. You have created a psychological barrier between your animals and the foxes.

Electric fencing:

- Can be fitted by you in most cases
- ✓ Is extremely effective in keeping foxes out
- ✓ Is 50% cheaper than traditional fencing

Foxes are intelligent animals. When they have a target in mind, they will do whatever it takes to get there. So we recommend using double fencing, even when you use electric fencing - the so-called external fencing. If a fox manages to get through the external fencing,

it will come across the internal fencing.
There are permanent and temporary solutions for keeping foxes out. In this leaflet we will explain the solutions for both situations.


Temporary solution


To be certain that your animals are not bothered by foxes, we recommend double fencing. Optimum security with internal and external fencing!

The internal fencing

The internal fencing is the Smartfence. Gallagher's unique all-in-1 system with posts, reels and wires. The system is 100 metres long and is also suitable for uneven

terrain. The main advantage of the SmartFence is that you set up or take down the system completely in just 5 minutes.








External fencing

It is important to position the external fencing at around 2 metres distance from the internal fencing. For an effective system we recommend external fencing that consists of short 75 cm fencing posts with two wires. The wires are fitted at 20 and 40 cm. With the unique Twist and Lock

system of our portable posts, you can be certain that the wires are tensioned and remain in place. The wire must have optimum conductivity, to ensure that the fox will receive a shock from any part of the fencing. Vidoflex 9 or 12 is the best choice.



THE ALTERNATIVE TO KEEPING FOXES OUT TEMPORARILY


For temporary fencing we also recommend putting up double fencing with internal and external fencing.

Internal fencing


An alternative to erecting a SmartFence (Gallagher's advice for temporary solutions for keeping foxes out), is electric netting. We recommend using chicken netting to keep foxes out. This netting has small mesh sizes, which means a fox cannot crawl through. We also recommend using netting with a double pin, for optimum strength

External fencing

It is important to position the external fencing at around 35 cm distance from the internal fencing. For an effective system we recommend external fencing that consists of short 75 cm fencing posts with two wires. The wires are fitted at 20 and 40 cm. With the unique Twist and Lock system of our portable posts, you can be certain that the wires are tensioned and remain in place. The wire must have optimum conductivity, to ensure that the fox will receive a shock from any part of the fencing. Vidoflex 9 or 12 is the best choice.

Semi-permanent solution


To be certain that your animals are not bothered by foxes, we recommend double fencing. Optimum security with internal and external fencing!

Internal fencing

With the Line Post 140 cm fencing with high tensile, you have a unique system that is just as strong as permanent wooden fencing, but you have fencing that is easy to move if necessary. The internal fencing is a 5-wire system with permanent posts. The distance between the posts is 7 m. The wire heights are 9.5 cm, 30 cm, 45.5 cm, 71 cm and 95 cm. The bottom wire is close to the ground, and it is easy for grass to grow up to it. You will need a powerful energizer to make sure that the grass is burned away and that conductivity remains at its best.

The MBS energizers offer a 3-in-1 solution, as they can be used on mains, battery and solar power.






External fencing

The external fencing is built with our blue plastic post of 0.7 m with two High Tensile wires. The distance from the internal fencing is 35 cm.

The wires are fitted at 20 and 50 cm. With this external fencing, foxes are given an additional barrier to reaching their target.

If you need to provide your animals with permanent protection against fox attacks, a Gallagher high-tensile system is ideal for you. This solution in combination with Insultimber posts provides maximum security.


Permanent solution

To be certain that your animals are not bothered by foxes, we recommend double fencing. Optimum security with internal and external fencing!

Internal fencing

The internal fencing is a 5-wire Insultimber system with permanent and floating posts. The floating posts keep the fencing tensioned and they save work, because you need to ram fewer posts into the ground. The wire heights are 90 cm, 65 cm, 45 cm, 30 cm and 15 cm. The bottom wire

is close to the ground, and it is easy for grass to grow up to it. You will need a powerful energizer to make sure that the grass is burned away and that conductivity remains at its best. Ask your Gallagher specialist for advice.







External fencing

The external fencing is a high-tensile fence with a short post of $1\,\text{m}$, at about 50 cm into the ground. The distance between the posts is $10\,\text{metres}$. The wires are fitted at

10 and 45 cm. With this external fencing, foxes are given an additional barrier to reaching their target. The distance between the internal and external fencing is 35 cm.
